AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF TWIN OAKS, MISSOURI TO AMEND SECTION 220.020 PERTAINING TO FISHING IN THE PARK

WHEREAS, while fishing is generally permitted in the lake in Twin Oaks Park, there may be time when the City finds it necessary to prohibit or limit fishing; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen desires to amend the fishing regulations to allow the Mayor or Board to temporarily ban fishing in the Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF TWIN OAKS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Chapter 220 ("Park Regulations"), Section 220.020 ("Uses and Prohibitions"), Subsection T ("Fishing") of the Twin Oaks Municipal Code is hereby amended by repealing Subsection T in its entirety and replacing it with a new Subsection T, to read as follows:

Section 220.020. Uses and Prohibitions.

T. Fishing. Unless prohibited on a temporary basis by order of the Mayor or Board of Aldermen (with appropriate signage posted), fishing is allowed in waters or waterways in the park, but all fish taken must be returned alive to the waters (catch and release). With the exception of the catch and release requirement, fishing in the park is governed by the rules and regulations in the State of Missouri Conservation Commission Wildlife Code including compliance with applicable fishing permit and season requirements.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
